

Since only soft spike golf shoes are permitted in most clubhouses, consider these points when choosing carpet:

- Cut pile rather than loop construction.
- While there is no general industry standard, some producers recommend a minimum pile yarn density of 5,000 ounces/cubic yard..
- Manufacturers should be contacted as to the appropriateness of any product to be installed in areas where soft spike shoes are allowed.

Additional Considerations

- Safety is a top concern for most clubs. Not only does carpet reduce the likelihood of slips and falls, but also minimizes the chance of injury from a fall.
- The variety of styles, patterns and colors available in carpet provides a tremendous number of design options. Consider using borders, patterns, and textures in combinations.
